Applications <u>MUST</u> be returned by mail or in person at the <u>Chambersburg Fire Department</u>, 130 N. Second Street, Chambersburg, PA 17201(Monday through Friday – 8 am to 4 pm (No Holiday Drop offs)) All applications must be turned in <u>no later than Saturday June 5, 2021 at 10:00 AM</u>. All applicants must be 18 years old by the application deadline. All applications will be turned over to the Borough Secretary for processing. *** (Applications may be dropped off on Saturday June 5, 2021 until 10:00 AM – This is the only Saturday available for in-person drop off)

NOTE: A \$20.00 fee is required when applications are submitted in any form. The check or money order for \$20.00 should be made payable to the <u>Borough of Chambersburg</u>. The application will not be processed if the fee is not received.

Also, note that <u>both</u> your application and background require acknowledgment that all is true and correct under penalty of law to be accepted. *Applications should be submitted in a timely manner

DATE, TIME AND LOCATION OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION: Tuesday, June 8, 2021 – 5:30 PM

To be conducted in Chambersburg Recreation Center (Bard Hall – downstairs-Southside of the building) 235 South Third Street, Chambersburg, PA. In order to participate on test day, your <u>application and payment</u> must have been received. No monies or applications will be collected on test day. Test starts promptly at 5:30 pm and no admittance will be allowed after the start of the test. "Borough mandated COVID procedures regarding masks and distancing will be enforced. Please bring a mask with you for the written test."

All applicants will need to get a score of at least 70% on the written exam to take the second part of the testing process which is the physical agility test (a pass/fail test). Physical agility testing information is included within the application packet.

ELIGIBILITY EXAMINATION FOR POSITION OF FIREFIGHTER IN THE CHAMBERSBURG FIRE DEPARTMENT

The purpose of this examination is to develop an eligibility listing for the position of Firefighter in the event of a vacancy. Veterans will be given preference in accordance with law.

All positions with the Borough of Chambersburg that require direct contact with children under age 18 are required to provide a background check sufficient to determine child abuse clearance which includes:

- A Child Abuse Clearance through the Child Welfare Portal
- A Pennsylvania State Police Request for Criminal History Check
 - A FBI Fingerprint Criminal History Clearance

You must be 18 years of age or older, in good physical condition, of good moral character and must pass a written examination and a physical agility test to be placed on the eligibility list.

You must be a high school graduate or have equivalent experience or training.

Must have and maintain a valid Commonwealth of Pennsylvania motor vehicle operator's license, 3 years clean driving history, and be insurable in the independent opinion of the Borough's motor vehicle insurance underwriter, in order to be eligible for this position.

You must obtain and retain a Commercial Driver's License and successfully complete an accredited Emergency Vehicle Operations Course prior to the end of your first six months of employment.

You must be a resident or take up residence within 25 driving miles of the corporate boundaries of the Borough of Chambersburg within one year of the date of employment.

Your workweek will average 42 hours. Overtime will be paid for all hours other than your regularly scheduled shifts in accordance with the Collective Bargaining Agreement.

You'll start at \$55,062.70 (2021) annually, with raises during and after 1 years' probation with advancement increases up to a maximum for Firefighter VII of \$72,015.10 (2021) annually. You will receive disability insurance, life insurance and retirement benefits. Your uniforms and equipment will be furnished.

If hired you must successfully complete the Harrisburg Area Community College Fire Academy.

You become eligible for vacation after one year of employment.

Opportunities may be available for a fluent Bilingual English-Spanish Firefighter appointment, should one become available. The applicant should indicate on their application that they are fluent in both Spanish and English.

FIRE CANDIDATE

PHYSICAL AGILITY TEST

These are minimum standards for all applicants. This is a pass/fail test. Failure of any of the tests will result in the applicant being disqualified.

- 1. <u>Hose stacking</u> to top rack by picking up and stacking eight (8) hose bundles and then returning them to their original location within three minutes.
- 2. Ladder climbing by ascending and descending a 65 foot ladder.
- 3. <u>Hose relay</u> requiring a hose bundle to be carried fifty (50) yards and a 2-1/2 inch hose to be extended fifty (50) yards, and then both to be returned to their original positions within three minutes.
- 4. <u>Obstacle course</u> requires carrying a hose bundle and climbing, crawling and running to complete the course in one minute, thirty seconds.
- 5. <u>Charged hose reposition</u> requires the moving of a charged hose over a series of barrels in two minutes.

If it is not attached, you may not be eligible to take the examination.

- 1. Each applicant for a position in the Police and Fire Departments shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age, a citizen of the United States (in cases of foreign born applicants, evidence satisfactory to the Commission shall be produced showing a person to be a naturalized citizen), and shall have graduated from an accredited high school or have an equivalent education acceptable to state standards. Any applicant who is physically disabled and unfit for the performance of the duties of the position to which he seeks employment, or who is addicted to habitual use of intoxicating liquors or narcotic drugs, or who has been guilty of any crime involving moral turpitude or of infamous or notorious disgraceful conduct or who has been dismissed from public service for delinquency or misconduct of office or who is affiliated with any group whose policies or activities are subversive to the form of government set forth in the Constitution and laws of the United States and Pennsylvania will not be eligible to take the examination.
- 2. Vacancies are filled by Borough Council through a conditional appointment of a qualified candidate who is certified by the Civil Service Commission. This appointment is conditioned on the candidate's successful passage of a physical exam, including drug screening, a psychological appraisal and a fitness assessment. Additionally, candidates for police officer will be subject to a polygraph examination for verifying the accuracy and completeness of the information furnished on the application form, statements of personal history or during interviews and background investigations. This examination will be completed only after the written examination and the physical agility test are successfully passed.

3. When certifying names to Borough Council from the Eligible List, the Commission will note whether or not the applicant is a user or non-user of tobacco products. A user of tobacco products is an individual, who at the time of application, is a

- 2. Climbing and/or crawling over and around walls and other obstacles while carrying a hose bundle;
- 3. Lifting and stacking hose bundles on a rack; lifting and setting up fire ladders;
- 4. Pushing motor vehicles;

- 5. Pulling or carrying accident and/or fire victims;
- 6. Ascending and descending stairs wearing turnout gear and carrying breathing apparatus and hose lines.
- 7. Lifting and placing patients on stretchers and transporting to ambulance; involves the carrying of patients down stairs on a stretcher;
- 8. Ascending and descending a 65 foot ladder;
- 9. Withstanding prolonged exposure to extreme weather conditions;
- 10. Withstanding prolonged periods of standing and sitting;
- 11. Withstanding frequent exposure to stress-producing situations such as encountering persons injured or killed by fires, accidents, crimes or suicide;
- 12. Communicating effectively with individuals suffering from trauma (including family members, friends or others who may have witnessed the trauma); communicating effectively with individuals when conducting inspections.
- 13. Operating a motor vehicle such as an ambulance or fire truck in emergency situations and for long periods of time;
- 14. Filling out written reports in a clear and concise manner; entering data in computer.
